



SULLIVAN RENAISSANCE SCHOLARSHIP

A DONOR-ADVISED FUND OF THE COMMUNITY FOUNDATION OF ORANGE & SULLIVAN COUNTY

This year the Community Foundation of Orange and Sullivan County, through a donor-advised fund established by Sullivan Renaissance, will offer a limited number of scholarships to volunteers who make significant contributions to a 2017 Sullivan Renaissance project. These scholarships are available for undergraduate educational studies at the college of one's choice for the Spring 2018 semester. Awarded scholarship funds will be released to recipients' college financial office upon receipt of a Spring tuition bill.

For an application to be considered by the donor-advised fund, the following criteria must be met:

1. Candidate must be a resident of Sullivan County.
2. Candidate must demonstrate that they have volunteered for a 2017 Sullivan Renaissance project **in a significant way**. Contributions may include gardening, beautification / caring for public spaces, project documentation, outreach or fundraising. *Please contact Sullivan Renaissance if you have questions about eligible activities.
3. They could also help with publicity and outreach, a plan fundraiser, create a video...
4. A letter from the project leader along with one additional letter of recommendation must be included. Determination and award amounts will be made based on the extent of the applicant's volunteerism.
5. Candidate should provide responses to the questions listed below. Use a separate sheet of paper if needed. Note – A video or portfolio may be included along with one's submission.
6. Scholarships may only be used for undergraduate studies.
7. Funds are awarded as available.
8. If awarded a scholarship, the recipient will need to provide a copy of their tuition bill. (Payment address for Institution must be included). Payment will be made directly to the college/university.
