\*Healthier Generation Competition Grants require that groups finish their project and submit a final report by May 31, 2025, making them eligible to participate in a judging process. A second round of grants (Phase II awards) are then given to the best projects in this category at the Empowering a Healthier Generation Celebration and Awards Ceremony in the fall.
